Orchestra auditions are designed to highlight your strengths in the following areas: technical prowess, *cantabile* playing, and all-around musicianship. Each applicant should present three selections as noted under your instrument below.

General Video Application Guidelines

- 1. Applicant should state full name, date of video recording and age at time of recording.
- 2. Piano accompaniment is not necessary

FRENCH HORN

- 1. First movement exposition of a concerto by Mozart, R. Strauss or Glière.
- 2. A contrasting work from the 19th or 20th century.
- 3. Choose <u>one</u> excerpt from (all horn 1 parts):
 - Tchaikovsky, Symphony 5, 2nd mvt, beginning solo to 9 after rehearsal A.
 - Brahms Symphony 4, mvt 1, rehearsal C to F, and rehearsal M to 2 measures before rehearsal Q.
 - R. Strauss, Ein Heldenleben, rehearsal 53 to 64, and from rehearsal 75 to 84.
 - R. Strauss, Till Eulenspiegel, opening to rehearsal 1, and from 11th bar of rehearsal 9 to rehearsal 11, and from rehearsal 37 to 4 before rehearsal 38

TRUMPET

- 1. The exposition of the 1st movement of either the Hummel concerto (either E major or E-flat major) or the Haydn concerto.
- 2. A contrasting work from the 19th or 20th century.
- 3. Choose <u>one</u> excerpt from (all Tpt 1 parts):
 - Mussorgsky/Ravel Pictures at an Exhibition, Promenade.
 - Mahler Symphony 5, first mvt, beginning to rehearsal 2, AND from rehearsal 9 to rehearsal 12.
 - Respighi Pines of Rome, first movement, beginning to rehearsal 8, AND last movement, from 15 measures after rehearsal 20 to the end.
 - Stravinsky Petruschka, Cornet 1 part: 3rd scene, Ballerina's dance, and Waltz, from rehearsal 75 to 76.

TROMBONE

- 1. The exposition of a standard concerto or other solo work.
- 2. A contrasting work from the 19th or 20th century.
- 3. Choose <u>one</u> excerpt (all trombone 1 parts):
 - Rossini, Overture to William Tell, rehearsal C to rehearsal E.
 - Rossini, Overture to La Gazza Ladra, rehearsal 3 to rehearsal 4, AND rehearsal 7 to *Più mosso* after rehearsal 9.
 - Berlioz, Hungarian March, 1 before rehearsal 4 to 3 after rehearsal 5.
 - Wagner, Die Walküre, Ride of the Valkyries, from rehearsal 3 with pick-up to third measure of rehearsal 6.

TUBA

- 1. A solo work of the applicant's choice.
- 2. A contrasting solo work of the applicant's choice.
- 3. Choose <u>one</u> excerpt from the following:
 - Respighi, The Pines of Rome, from pick-up to rehearsal 11 to 5 after rehearsal 16.
 - Wagner, Ride of the Valkyries, from 8 before rehearsal 11 (with pick-up) to rehearsal 12.
 - R. Strauss, Till Eulenspiegels Lustige Streiche, from 8 before rehearsal 19 to 16 after rehearsal 19, AND from 7 before rehearsal 37 to 4 before rehearsal 38.
 - R. Strauss, Ein Heldenleben, rehearsal 8 to rehearsal 9, AND from 2 before rehearsal 58 to rehearsal 66.
